Sensuikyo About 50,000 miyama-kirishima nododendrons grow wild in this valley. The best time to see the flowers is from mid-May when they are in full bloom and cover the mountainsides in pink. The paths are well-maintained and crowded with tourists during the blooming season.

This waterfall consists of Otoko Falls (height: about 80 meters) and Onna Falls (height: about 100 meters). At the coldest parts of the year, the frigid winds from the Aso Valley freeze the falls, creating beautiful, delicate ice sculptures along the exposed rock face.
