

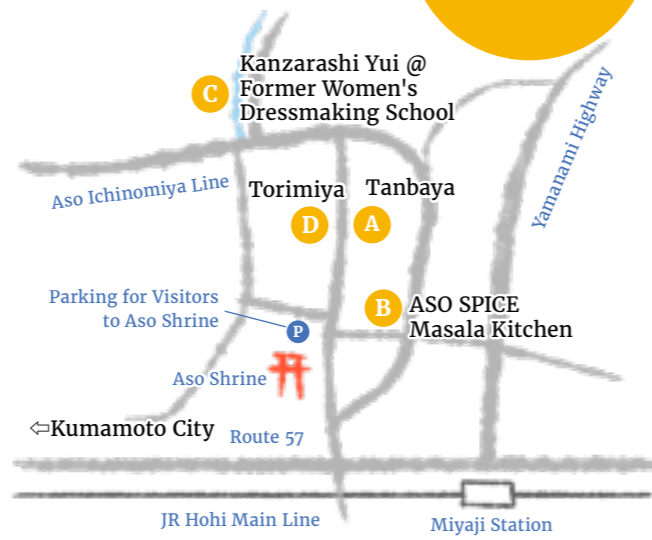
See the sights in Monzen machi & Uchino maki

Monzenmachi Area

The Monzenmachi Shopping Street extends from the approach to Aso Shrine. Thirty-six spring water fountains called *mizuki* are scattered throughout the nearby neighborhood and are great when you need a quick drink of water. Various stores, cafes, and souvenir shops in the area make for an enjoyable day out.

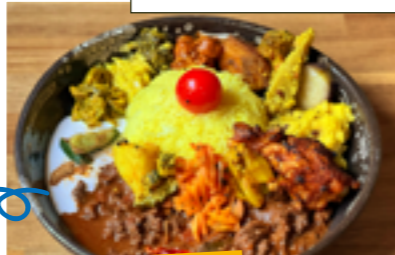
ASO SPICE Masala Kitchen

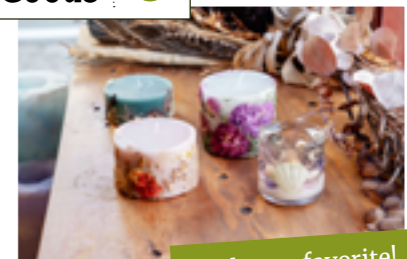


Kho Handmade Goods

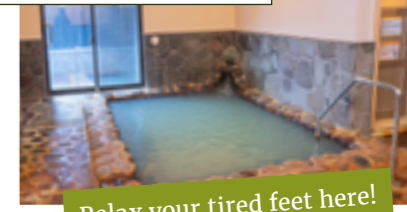
Take a step back in time
