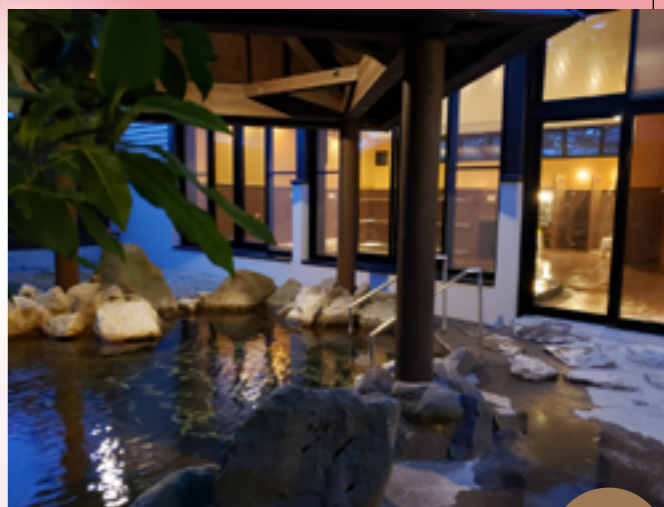

## Natural hot springs are the best healing Yume no Yu - Aso Bochu Onsen

Bochu

This municipal onsen was built using local lumber. The characteristic brown-tinged color of this iron sulfate spring leaves you feeling warm and toasty after your bath. Feel the freedom of bathing outdoors in the roofed outdoor baths! The large public bath also features an infrared sauna and cold water bath. Relax in the tatami-floored rest area after your soak. Free footbaths are also available.

## A moisturizing dip in a bath cures all Aso Plaza Hotel

A staple of Uchinomaki Onsen established over half a century ago, the baths at Aso Plaza Hotel feature spring water that bubbles up from two springs on-site and offer great views of the Five Peaks of Aso. The Hobo no Yu on the 2nd floor of the annex is open to non-overnight guests. The spring is a mildly radioactive (sodium/calcium) sulfate spring that supposedly cures all ills. A relaxing soak in the hot spring will heal both body and soul.

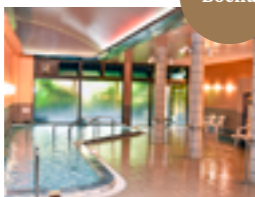

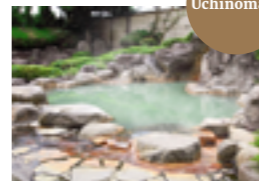
